Department of Pennsylvania Marine Corps League 2022 Pistol Match Information Sheet Service And Open Matches

The Department Pistol Service and Open Matches will be held annually between 1 March and 31 October and referred to as the shooting season. Any Detachment in the Department of Pennsylvania may sponsor one or more matches during the shooting season. Registration forms will be handled by sponsoring Detachments.

All Department Pistol Service and Open Matches must be sanctioned by Department of Pennsylvania Marine Corps League and the sponsoring Detachment. The following requirements must be met to sponsor a sanctioned Pistol Match.

Approval from Pistol Range sponsor with information for insurance and other costs.

Pistol range sponsor will have range official(s) available during pistol match.

Hold Harmless Forms for Pistol Range, Detachment, & Department of Pennsylvania MCL

PA Department of Pennsylvania Insurance coverage approval for Pistol Match.

Department of Pennsylvania MCL approval of Pistol Match.

Pistol Match Flyer with date, time, location, and entry costs.

Letter from Detachment approving the sponsoring of the Pistol Match.

Detachment Commandant will be responsible for following the Pistol Match rules listed in this document.

To avoid appearance of scoring conflict with Detachment Commandant; Pistol Range sponsor will certify scores.

Detachment sponsored matches will have fees to cover expenses, such as insurance, targets and range costs.

There will be fees for all shooters that submit scores for Department awards. All shooters can participate at multiple matches but must only submit one score for service and/or open match Department Awards by November 31st along with a registration fee. The fee is \$10 per competitor per score and \$20 per team. A competitor may submit more than one score (i.e. one for individual and one for team).

Shooters will have their score cards verified by the Detachment sponsoring the match and then posted to all match participants and shared with the Department of Pennsylvania Pistol Chairman by electronic document.

The team's registration form(s) must be typed or legibly printed with the competitor's full legal name using no nick names or aliases. The scores sheets must be verified and signed by the Detachment Commandant to certify the match scores are true and correct.

Team Composition

- Pistol match teams must consist of four (4) or five (5) competitors.
- A team consisting of four (4) competitors will receive a blind score.
- A blind score will be calculated as an average from the registered shooter and will be assigned to the teams as the fifth score.
- Entries of three or less are eligible for individual awards and not eligible for team awards.
- Teams may be from a Marine Corps League Detachment, a Reserve Unit, an Active Duty Unit or a Young Marines Unit.
- More than one team may be entered from a Detachment or Unit.
- All competitors on a team must be from the same Detachment or Unit.
- A competitor cannot be a member of more than one team.

- An Active or Reserve competitor can fire on a Marine Corps League Detachment team if he or she is a member of a Detachment.
- Young Marines Units may enter under Pistol Match rules for Young Marines.

Team and Individual Classifications

- Pistol teams will be classified as High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, or Marksman according to the competitors on the team.
- Teams are classified by calculating the team average based on the classification of each firing member of the team. To calculate the team's average a numeric representation of each classification is used, and the team classification is the sum of the team member's classifications divided by the number of firing members of the team. Any decimals of 0.5 and greater will place the team in the next higher class.

- First time competitors that are not NRA Conventional Pistol classified will be assigned a Master classification which will be used for the current match and will be reclassified after the current year's match to their new Marine Corps League Classification.
- Competitors that have been classified by the NRA will have that classification honored upon verification of their classification card. Please enclose a photocopy copy of your classification card.

General Match Information

- The Detachment or Unit must fire at a local gun club, military base, or sanctioned tournament where the course of fire is the same as the MCL Postal Match course of fire.
- The range length for the pistol match must be 25 Yards.

Pistol Match

- The following pistols or their civilian models are acceptable. Government Model 1911.45 ACP (Gold Cup and Officer's models are acceptable); Beretta M9, .38 caliber six-cylinder revolvers.
- Any type of internal modification is acceptable except for trigger pull which must meet or exceed the minimum four (4) pound trigger pull as designated by the U.S. Armed Forces.
- Only standard metallic sights can be used and no other sighting or aiming device such as lasers, red dots, etc. can be attached to the pistol in any manner.
- Standard grips must not exceed one and a half (1 1/2) inches and cannot have finger groves or other non-standard military design.
- Two hand grip is acceptable for both the Service Pistol Match and the Open Pistol Match.

Course of Fire:

- Two stages with each stage containing one string of slow fire, two strings of timed fire and two strings of rapid fire.
- 10 Rounds, 10 minutes Slow Fire
- Two (2) five-round strings, 20 Seconds, Timed Fire
- Two (2) five-round strings, 10 Seconds, Rapid-Fire
- There will be a pause between the Timed and Rapid-Fire strings for reloading.

Alibis:

- Alibis apply only to the timed and rapid-fire strings.
- A competitor can claim only one alibi in both strings of fire for a stage
- A competitor can only fire one alibi string consisting of the string with the fewest shots down range at the time of the alibi.
- Target: Standard NRA B-8 25-yard pistol target

Awards

- Awards will be distributed for first place High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, and Marksman for Individuals and Teams.
- There will be 2nd and 3rd place awards awarded depending on the amount of entryfees received and the number of competitors per classification.
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Pistol Open Match

- The open pistol match is designed to give shooters access to the Postal Match who do not own or have access to military type pistols required for the Service Pistol Match.
- Open Match pistols may be revolver or semi-automatic type handgun larger than .22 caliber and smaller than .50 caliber.
- Only standard metallic sights can be used and no other sighting or aiming device such as lasers, red dots, etc. can be attached to the pistol in any manner.
- The Open Pistol Match is an identical course of fire and scoring to the service pistol course listed above.
