Rifle Match Information for Service, Open, and Optical Matches

The Department Rifle Service, Open, and Optical Matches will be held annually between 1 March and 31 October and referred to as the shooting season. Any Detachment in the Department of Pennsylvania may sponsor one or more matches during the shooting season. Registration forms will be handled by sponsoring Detachments.

All Department Rifle Matches must be sanctioned by Department of Pennsylvania Marine Corps League and the sponsoring Detachment. The following requirements must be met to sponsor a sanctioned Pistol Match.

Approval from Rifle Range sponsor with information for insurance and other costs.

Rifle range sponsor will have range official(s) available during rifle match.

Hold Harmless Forms for Rifle Range, Detachment, & Department of Pennsylvania MCL

PA Department of Pennsylvania Insurance coverage approval for Rifle Match.

Department of Pennsylvania MCL approval of Rifle Match.

Rifle Match Flyer with date, time, location, and entry costs.

Letter from Detachment approving the sponsoring of the Rifle Match.

Match Chairman will be responsible for following the Rifle Match rules listed in this document.

To avoid appearance of scoring conflict, Rifle Range sponsor will certify scores.

Detachment sponsored matches will have fees to cover expenses, such as insurance, targets, and range costs.

There will be fees for all shooters that submit scores for Department awards. All shooters can participate at multiple matches but must only submit one score for each match Department Awards before December 31st along with a registration fee. **The Department Match fee of \$10.00** will cover any and all rifle matches that each shooter participates in during the annual shooting schedule of March 1 through October 31. Additional match fees will be as shown on each match flyer for each match. A competitor may submit more than one score (i.e. one for individual and one for team).

All individual and team shooters registration forms must be typed or legibly printed with the competitor's full legal name (no nick names or aliases). All fees including the Department fee and forms are to be sent to the Match Chairperson as listed on the Match Flyer. The flyer will note the amount and address to send. Shooters will have their score cards verified by the Detachment sponsoring the match and then posted to all match participants and shared with the Department of Pennsylvania Rifle Chairman by electronic document.

Team Composition

- Rifle match teams must consist of four (4) competitors.
- Entries of three or less are eligible for individual awards and not eligible for team awards.
- Teams may be from a Marine Corps League Detachment, a Reserve Unit, or an Active-Duty Unit.
- More than one team may be entered from a Detachment or Unit.
- All competitors on a team must be from the same Detachment or Unit.
- A competitor cannot be a member of more than one team.
- An Active or Reserve competitor can fire on a Marine Corps League Detachment team if he or she is
- a member of a Detachment.

Team and Individual Classifications

- Rifle teams will be classified as High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, or Marksman according to the competitors on the team.
- Teams are classified by calculating the team average based on the classification of each firing member
- of the team. To calculate the team's average a numeric representation of each classification is used, and the team classification is the sum of the team member's classifications divided by the number of firing members of the team. Any decimals of 0.5 and greater will place the team in the next higher class.

- First time competitors that are not NRA Conventional Rifle classified will be assigned a Master classification which will be used for the current match and will be reclassified after the current year's match to their new Marine Corps League Classification.
- Competitors that have been classified by the NRA will have that classification honored upon verification of their classification card. Please enclose a photocopy copy of your classification card.

General Match Information

- The Detachment or Unit must fire at a local gun club, military base, or sanctioned tournament where the course of fire is the same as the MCL Rifle Match course of fire.
- The range length for the Rifle match must be 200 Yards unless that distance is not available on the local range in which case a reduced 200 yard simulated target will be used. Competitors are required to use empty chamber indicators at all times, except when in their prep period and live fire stages.
- Rifles in the prone shooting position must be unsupported and shall not have rifles supported by the magazine on the ground or shooting mat.

Rifle Match

- The following rifles or their civilian models are acceptable. Government Model 1903, 1917, Garand M1, M1A, AR-15.
- Any type of internal modification is acceptable except for trigger pull which must meet or exceed the minimum trigger pull of 4.5 lbs. as designated by the CMP.
- Only standard metallic sights can be used and no other sighting or aiming device such as lasers, red dots, etc. can be attached to the rifle in any manner except for the **optics class** in which case a maximum 4.5 power is permitted.
- **Course of Fire**
Three stages with each stage containing all slow fire single loaded rounds.

1st stage 10 rounds Offhand, 2nd stage 15 rounds sitting or kneeling and 3rd stage 15 rounds prone .

Alibis:

One alibi will be permitted in each stage of fire for a malfunction of a weapon or a round fails to fire.

Awards

Awards will be distributed for first place High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, and Marksman for Individuals and Teams.

- There will be 2nd and 3rd place awards awarded depending on the amount of entry fees received and the number of competitors per classification.

Rifle Open Match

- The open rifle match is designed to give shooters access to the Postal Match who do not own or have access to military type rifles required for the Service Rifle Match.
- Open Match rifles may be rifles having .223 caliber or larger and smaller than .50 caliber.
- Only standard metallic sights can be used and no other sighting or aiming device such as lasers, red dots, etc. can be attached to the rifle in any manner, except for the **optics class** in which case a maximum 4.5x power is permitted.
- The Open Rifle Match is an identical course of fire and scoring to the service rifle course listed above.

Rifle TARGETS

The rifle targets to be used are the standard SR 200-yard match targets as described in the CMP Match Rules or 200 yard simulated 200 yard for 100 and 50 yard ranges. They are 10 X target with an X ring, 10 ring, and 9 ring within the “Bullseye.”
