c(3) Charity since 2020. The Mission of this charity is to assist veterans and families to be able to go fishing or sightseeing on Codorus Lake, to relax and unwind and to share fishing skills with other veterans. There is no

cost to veterans – programs are free. Equipment such as fishing pole, worms and lures will be provided as well as water, snacks, suntan lotion and bathrooms which are located throughout the Lake. Also available are life jackets for adults and children with prior notice so we know what sizes to bring. There are three types of vessels available – pontoon boat, tracker bass boat and some kayaks. Depending on an individual's skill level, arrangements can be made to assist the veteran, so they have a great time on the Lake. Fishing license is required if fishing. The pontoon boat can be wheelchair accessible.

This benefit is provided through the Marine Corps League of Pennsylvania. NO, you are *NOT REQUIRED* to respond, but you MAY respond. If you do, sales folks from American Income Life will contact you.


