TOYS FOR TOT – our members participated in distributing and collecting toys from TFT boxes placed at 12 local business; volunteering approximately 72 hours. Total toys collected were approximately 1625 which were delivered to Carlisle TFT on December 19th.

FUNDRAISING:

- Dillsburg Farmers Fair Oct 17th & 18th – our Detachment supported this yearly event by operating a game where the kids won a prize every time they played. 9 members volunteered a total of 105 hours. Total proceeds = \$2,491
 - Fair Parade – our Detachment members participated in the Saturday evening parade by riding in a Deuce ½ and celebrating the Marine Corps.
- Gun Raffle – our Detachment sponsored a gun raffle which is our biggest fundraising event of the year, ending Nov 10, 2025. 12 members volunteered approximately 685 coordinating and selling tickets for 10 months. Total proceeds = \$5,627.82.
